## WEEKDAY ROUTINE

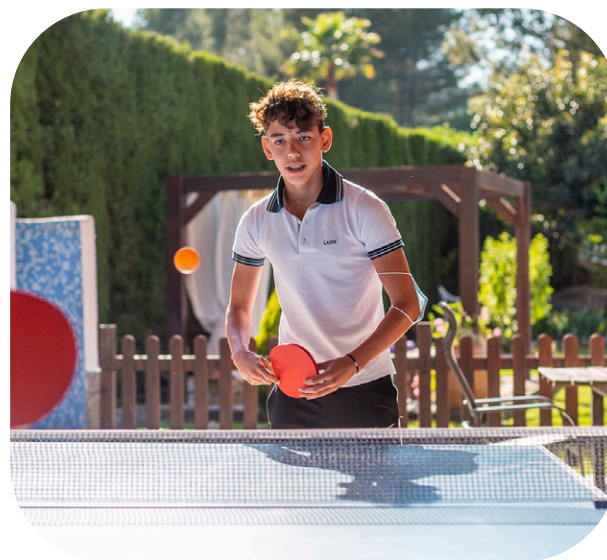
- 07:30** Wake up. Shower and dress for school.
- 07:45** Breakfast.
- 08:00** Personal housekeeping duties; students must leave their rooms tidy.
- 08:15** Students leave for school and take everything needed for their studies that day as there is no access back into the boarding house until school finishes.
- 08:45** Arrival at school.
- 16:15** End of School Day. Prep or Plus Clubs at school.
- 17:30** Bus leaves school for the Boarding House.
- 18:00** Dinner – students should arrive clean and neat for dinner.
- 18:45** Free time – choose an activity, organised games or relaxation.
- 19:00** PREP. Boarders who did not complete prep at school may use this time to study either in their rooms, the common area upstairs or the dining room. Staff are on hand to assist where needed.
- 20:00** End of Prep - free time.
- 21:00** Supper snack available in dining room.
- 21:45** Return to bedrooms and prepare for school, showers and get ready for bed. This should be a quiet time until lights out.
- 22:00** Boarders lights out (except Sixth Form).
- 22:30** Sixth Form lights out.



## BOARDING FACILITIES COMPRISES

The Boarding Facility comprises of a large traditional farmhouse which has been tastefully decorated, furnished and provides 3 separate independent areas.

These include two comfortable commons rooms, one main dining hall and kitchen.



## PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY

Students are encouraged to take personal responsibility for themselves, their own bedrooms and living space and the decisions they make daily. They will learn about accountability in terms of personal choices and will be encouraged to be the best they can.

**REGISTRATION FEE**  
(Only New Students)  
**€1.500**

Non-refundable, one-time payment, paid upon admittance of a new student. These funds are used for capital works at the school.

**ENROLMENT FEE**  
(New and Current students)  
**€1.000**

Non-Refundable payment to secure a place in the school.

**STUDENT RESIDENT PERMIT**  
(Non EU only)  
**€1.000**

Includes legal fees in Spain and translation of documents (NON EU only).
